In accordance with the announcement of the results for the Rajiv Gandhi University Common Entrance Test (RGUCET-2025) (LL.B.) and Common University Entrance Test (CUET-PG-2025) (LL.B.), the college will conduct counselling-cum-admission for the LL.B. Three Years Course for the academic session 2025-26 as per the schedule given below:

- 1. There will be a 3% reservation of seats for person with disabilities (PwD) as per the State Government's reservation policy, notified from time to time.
- 2. According to RGU circular no. AC-56/OAS-RGUCET/RGUPET/2022 (Vol-III) dated 5th July 2024, admission of applicants will be based on RGUCET (80%) and CUET-PG (20%). Any vacant seats in CUET-PG will be filled through RGUCET.

If the selected candidate failed to take admission to the college within the specified period, the seat shall be forfeited and not be eligible for admission thereafter. The <u>second round of counselling –cum- admission for vacant seats</u> will be conducted according to the following schedule:

Admission to vacant seats will be based solely on merit and contingent upon seat availability.

The waiting listed candidates must report for counselling - cum - admission between 10:30 am and 11:00 am, and they must mark their attendance during this period. Only those who mark their attendance within this timeframe will be considered for further admission procedures.

The selected students who did not appear in the first round of counselling – cum - admission are ineligible for consideration in the second round for vacant seats.
